

Note about tomatoes: Determinate tomatoes are bushy and tend to produce fruits all at one time, which is great for canning. Indeterminate tomatoes are larger vines that will produce over a longer period of time in smaller numbers. Unless noted, all are heirloom or open pollinated.

Amish Paste

Bright red 8-12 ounce fruits vary in shape from oxheart to rounded plum. Delicious flesh is juicy and meaty, excellent for sauce or fresh eating. One of Slow Food USA's Ark of Taste varieties. 85 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Big Beef (hybrid)

Large yields of colossal beefsteak tomatoes. Plants are drought tolerant and thrive in a variety of climates. Uniform, smooth-skinned, blemish-free fruit is globe shaped, 10-12 oz. Fruits are crack resistant and have a deep red color. Excellent for canning, slicing and salads. 80-85 days. Indeterminate. Excellent disease resistance.



Black Cherry

The standard for rich cherry tomato flavor, wonderfully flavored, juicy fruits. Small cherry tomatoes averaging 1" across grow in clusters. Has a good, sweet cherry tomato flavor. Rich, sweet, juicy, flavor. 65-75 days.



Black Cherry has deep red/black plentiful clusters. Excellent yields. Indeterminate.

Black Krim

Open pollinated heirloom originating from the Black Sea area in Russia. Vining plants produce large beefsteak type tomatoes that are purplish red to almost black. Excellent flavor.

Much asked-for favorite. Vining plants produce large 8-12 oz dusty rose-brown tomatoes. Delicious sweet flesh. Heirloom from Tennessee/ North Carolina area.
