

Note about tomatoes: Determinate tomatoes are bushy and tend to produce fruits in one large batch, which is great for canning. Indeterminate tomatoes are larger vines that will produce over a longer period of time in smaller numbers. Unless noted, all are heirloom or open pollinated.



Amish Paste

Large bright red 8-12 ounce fruits vary in shape from oxheart to rounded plum. Delicious, juicy and meaty; makes rich sauce, thick pastes and great for salads.

One of Slow Food USA's Ark of Taste varieties.

75-85 days from transplant. Heirloom.

Indeterminate.

Big Beef (hybrid)

Large yields of colossal beefsteak tomatoes, even in the most adverse of conditions. Plants are drought tolerant and thrive in a variety of climates. Uniform, smooth-skinned, blemish-free fruit is globe shaped, 10-12 oz that are crack resistant with deep red color. Excellent for canning, slicing and salads. Indeterminate. Excellent disease resistance.



Brandywine

One of the original beefsteak tomatoes, Brandywine is a very distinctive HEIRLOOM variety with large, lobed, slightly flattened fruits that grow up to 7". These potato-leaved vines produce tomatoes that are deep pinkish red, thin skinned and juicy with a sweet, rich, and slightly spicy flavor. 80-90 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Celebrity (hybrid)

Very popular F1 hybrid. Known for its bushy habit, flavorful fruit, heavy yield and disease resistance. Tomatoes are bright red and meaty, average 8 oz. Mature about 70 days from transplant. Determinate



Cherokee Purple

Much asked-for favorite. Vining plants produce large 8-12 oz dusty rose-brown tomatoes. Delicious sweet flesh.

Heirloom from Tennessee/ North Carolina area.

75-90 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Goliath Tomato

Large fruits that are 13 oz. or more. Goliath tomatoes are bright red, have a pleasing combination of sweetness and flavor. Blemish-free, smooth texture, vigorous, productive and highly- disease resistant.

78 days from transplant. Indeterminate.



Juliet Tomato

Sweet delicious grape tomatoes on very productive vines. Often called the mini Roma because of its shape. These tomatoes are not only great for salads or munching straight off the vines, but also have a long shelf life. 60- 70 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Mr. Stripey Tomato

Mr. Stripey are heirloom tomatoes that live up to their name with their yellow and red stripes. It's a sweet, low-acid flavor in a large sliceable colorful package. 70-80 days. Indeterminate.

Pineapple Tomato

Very large yellow fruits with red marbling. Heirloom tomatoes that are meaty and sweet; up to 2 lbs each. Late season, prolific beefsteak variety with very few seeds. 80-90 days to maturity. Indeterminate.

Pink Berkeley Tie Dye Tomato

Large heirloom tomatoes with colorful green, red, orange, yellow variations. No two tomatoes will be alike. Tasty beefsteak slicer. 8-12 oz. fruit mature 70-80 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Rocky Top Tomato

Bright red, round and smooth beefsteak type fruits on disease resistant bushy plants. Prolific producer with great flavor. Average 7-12 ozs each. 75 days to maturity. Determinate.

Rutgers Tomato

One of the best old-fashioned all purpose tomatoes. Ripens evenly from the inside out. Rich, mellow, full-bodied flavor in bright red fruits. Heavy tomatoes weigh an average of 7oz each. Disease resistant. Great for slicing or canning. 75 days. Determinate.

San Marzano Redorta Paste Tomato

Long wide tapered tomatoes with very few seeds. Great Italian paste tomatoes on medium sized vines. At 6-8 oz. the tomatoes are larger than its cousin San Marzano. 75-85 days from transplant. Open pollinated. Indeterminate.

Sausage Paste Tomato

Elongated narrow red paste tomatoes can grow up to 6" long. Prolific heirloom tomatoes that are great for adding to sauces or other canned tomatoes for body. 70-80 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Speckled Roman Tomato

Beautiful heirloom paste tomatoes with streaks of yellow on red fruits. Deep red inside when sliced. Long, slender, meaty tomatoes with tangy tomato flavor and very few seeds. Great for sauces and pastes. Matures 80-85 days from transplant. Indeterminate.

Sungold Tomato

Tangy sweet, juicy yellow/gold cherry tomatoes. Great for salads or eating straight off the vines. Fruits tend to grow in large clusters. 65-70 days. Indeterminate.



Super Sweet Tomato

Tiny, bright red, super sweet 1" cherry tomatoes. Large clusters of hundreds of miniature tomatoes that ripen throughout the season. Hybrid. 65-70 days. Indeterminate.
